Powers and Functions of the District Level Committee Hub for Empowerment of Women:

1. The Committee shall meet at least once in a quarter.
2. The Committee will also prepare the Annual Action Plan for the District under various components of the Scheme.
3. To facilitate inter-sectoral convergence of schemes and programmes for women at the District level.
4. To guide, link women/women's group to various institutional and schematic set ups for their empowerment and development.
5. To facilitate a mechanism for women so as to have equal access to health care, quality education, career and vocational counselling/ training, financial inclusion, entrepreneurship, social security, digital literacy, etc
6. To facilitate a mechanism for collection of data on various aspects related to women.
7. To address gaps in state action for women, improving access and utilization of government schemes for women.


